

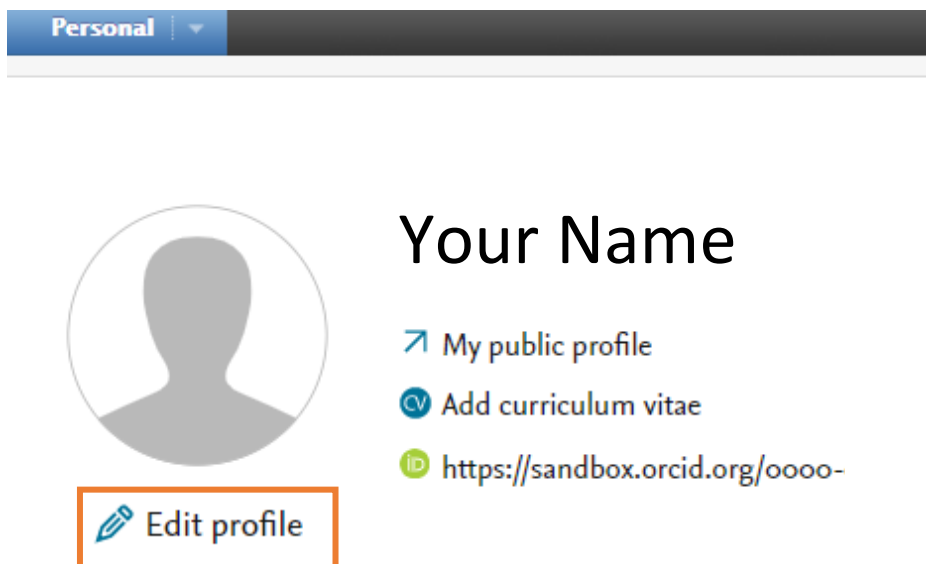
The network map feature on the new Edinburgh Research Explorer displays your collaborations with external research partners and the global reach of your research.

Network maps are generated from the affiliations of your co-authors on your research output records in Pure. The map displays the collaborations from research outputs published within the last five years.

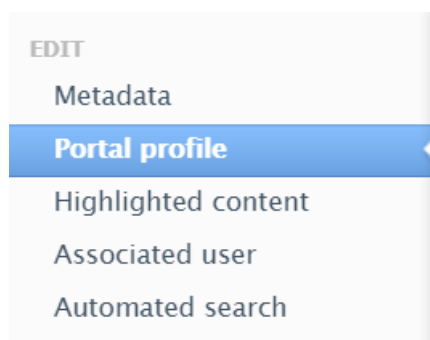
How to Turn Off Network Maps

You can turn off the network map on your profile page by following the steps below.

1. Log in to Pure with your University Login (formerly EASE) at <https://www.pure.ed.ac.uk>
2. Click on the **Personal** tab to return to the **Personal overview**



3. Click on **Edit Profile**



4. Click on '**Portal Profile**' to the left of your profile page. This tab will help you control how some content from your profile is shown on the Pure Portal.

5. Underneath **Collaboration Map** there is a slider labelled **Show Collaboration Map on profile**. Click on this slider to switch your network map on or off.

Collaboration Map

If Off, the Collaboration Map is hidden from both the Overview and Network sections of your profile on the Pure Portal. Note: Only the map is hidden, not the Network section.
